SUBJECT: PY 2014 WIA Title I – Youth, Adult and Dislocated Worker Activities Program Allocations

- Purpose:** To officially issue PY 2014 WIA Title I – Youth, Adult and Dislocated Worker Activities Program allocations to local workforce investment areas.
- General Information:** Youth Activities allocations were calculated according to the Workforce Investment Act of 1998, Public Law 105-220, Chapter 4 and Section 128(b)(2).

Adult Activities allocations were calculated according to the Workforce Investment Act of 1998, Public Law 105-220, Chapter 5 and Section 133(b)(2)(A).

Dislocated Worker Activities allocations were calculated according to the Workforce Investment Act of 1998, Public Law 105-220, Chapter 5 and Section 133(b)(2)(B).

The information below reflects the total allotment to the State of Arkansas for each funding stream, the reservations for statewide activities required under Public Law 105-220, Chapter 4 and Section 128(a), and Chapter 5 and Section 133(a) (1), as modified by the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2014, Public Law 113-76, and the reservation for statewide rapid response activities required under Public Law 105-220, Chapter 5 and Section 133(a)(2).

Special Notes:

- A. The Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2014, also specifies the following provisions, which are applicable to utilization of the funds appropriated:
- A local board still may transfer up to 30 percent of funds between the Adult and Dislocated Worker funding streams if approved by their Governor. (Arkansas has a waiver through June 30, 2017 allowing local boards to transfer up to 50 percent between those programs.)
 - A local board still may award contracts for “class-size training”. That is, a local board still may award a contract to an institution of higher education or other eligible training provider if the local board determines that the contract would facilitate the training of multiple individuals in high-demand occupations, and if the contract would not limit customer choice.
 - Notwithstanding section 128(a)(1) of WIA, the amount available for the Governor for Statewide workforce investment activities must not exceed 8.75 percent of the amount allotted to the State from each of the WIA Youth, Adult and Dislocated Worker PY 2014 appropriations.
 - Salary caps are imposed under Public Law 113-76, Division H, Title I, Section 105. No funds under the header “Employment and Training Administration” may be used by a recipient or sub-recipient to pay the salary and/or bonus of an individual, either as direct costs or indirect costs, at a rate in excess of Executive Level II, currently \$181,500. States also may establish lower salary caps.
- B. This Issuance provides the total PY 2014 allocation for each Title I funding stream. However, as of July 1, 2014, only the base portion of our state allotment of Adult and Dislocated Worker Activities funds will have been made available for distribution to local workforce investment areas. Therefore, initial sub grant awards of Adult and Dislocated Worker Activities funds will be for each local workforce investment area’s share of these base amounts. The balance of our state allotments of Adult and Dislocated Worker Activities funds will be made available on October 1, 2014.
- C. A separate Issuance will provide local workforce investment areas with PY 2014 funding information and sub grant award numbers. Youth Activities sub grant awards have an effective date of April 1, 2014. Adult and Dislocated Worker Activities sub grant awards will have an effective date of July 1, 2014 and October 1, 2014 respectively.
