Sequestration to Impact Emergency Unemployment Compensation Program

The Budget Control Act of 2011 (Public Law 112-25) requires across-the-board budget cuts to the Emergency Unemployment Compensation (EUC) program. This reduction is generally known as part of the “sequestration” budget cuts. Due to sequestration, all payments of EUC for weeks of unemployment that begin on or after March 31, 2013, must be reduced by 10.7 percent for weeks of unemployment through November 30, 2013.

If you are a first time filer for EUC benefits, you will receive a monetary determination reflecting your sequestration EUC weekly benefit amount and maximum benefit amount. If you are a current EUC recipient, you will be mailed a revised EUC monetary determination providing you with your revised EUC weekly benefit amount and new EUC maximum benefit amount. DWS will notify you in writing if there are subsequent changes affecting your EUC entitlement.
