The Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) was signed into law on July 22, 2014 and most provisions of the law went into effect on July 1, 2015. Passage of the WIOA is a pivotal event in workforce development. Concepts and practices like sector strategies, career pathways, industry partnerships, regional planning, work-based learning, unified services to employers, team-based case management, and braided funding are among the core change elements of the WIOA.

Local Workforce Development Boards have a tremendous responsibility under the new law for strategic planning, oversight, alignment of resources, and improving the structure and delivery of services.

The Arkansas Department of Workforce Services in partnership with the U.S. Department of Labor, is sponsoring a one-day training for all local workforce development board members. This interactive training will provide board members with vital information about their role as board members and workforce development leaders in their communities.
