SUBJECT: Additional Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Title I PY 2018 Youth and FY 2019 Adult and Dislocated Worker (DLW) Activities Program Allocations

Purpose: To issue additional allocations of WIOA Title I PY 2018 Youth and FY 2019 Adult and DLW Activities program funds to local workforce development areas (LWDAs).

General Information: Change 2 to TEG 16-17 informs states that funding for PY 2018 is adjusted to restore the PY 2018 appropriated funding set aside for program integrity purposes. Division H, Title I, sec. 106(b) of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2018, allows the Secretary of Labor to set aside a portion of grant funds for program integrity. The Department has decreased the amount of funds it plans to set aside for this purpose and has restored the remaining funding to the state allotments.

Arkansas will not retain any of these funds for Statewide Activities but will retain the allowable 5 percent for administration from each funding stream and the allowable 25 percent for Rapid Response activities from the DLW funding stream. The balance of each funding stream will be distributed to our LWDAs according to formula. Each LWDA will receive a unilateral modification to each of its PY 2018 Youth and FY 2019 Adult and DLW subgrant awards. The attached tables provide LWDAs the amount of additional funding they will receive.

Action Required: Upon receipt of the unilateral modifications, LWDAs will be required to submit revised subgrant award Funding Allocation Forms.
