More information on the Farm and Food Workers Relief Program:

- The Farm and Food Workers Relief Program (FFWR) is a national program funded by the United States Department of Agriculture.
- United Migrant Opportunity Services (UMOS), a non-profit organization, serves as the lead administrative agency for the program.
- The Arkansas Human Development Corporation, a state-wide private non-profit corporation, administers the FFWR program in Arkansas.
- Applying for this one-time relief payment through the FFWR program is free and completely voluntary.
- Applying will not result in inspection of property and/or workers as inspection of property and/or workers is not required in order for workers to receive the assistance and has not been mandated by any state or federal official.
- To be considered for the program, the applicant must provide proof of employment as a farm or food worker during the COVID-19 pandemic (1/27/2020-5/11/2023) along with proof of identification.
- Proof of employment can be provided by uploading documentation such as a paystub to the application. A list of other potential proof of identity/employment documents is available at bit.ly/ApplyFFWR.
- If the applicant is eligible for the program, their one-time relief payment will be sent via mail in the form of a gift-card.
